Proposed Alterations to the Jaccos Towne Lodge Plan Book 8-24-08

- Pg 3 Lodge Program, Lodge Summer Camp/ Fellowship Program, altered to read "Lodge Summer Camp Ordeal/Fellowship Program
- 2. Pg 3 Lodge Program, regarding the dates of the "Lodge Brotherhood Ceremony", "Lodge Fall Fellowship", and "Lodge Vigil Honor Ceremony", altered the dates to say "September/October".
- 3. Pg 3 Lodge Program, "Section C2C Conclave" altered to say "Section Conclave" and date altered to "As Decided by Section"
- 4. Pg 6 Article III, Section 2, "Elections": policy on receiving unit election forms altered so that unit election forms will not be accepted after the March LEC for that year's Ordeal season.
- Pg 7 Article IV, Section 3, "Chapter Officers": section altered to coincide with National Policy that a Chapter's Officers shall include a Chief, Vice Chief, and Secretary
- 6. Pg 7-8, Article IV, Section 4, "Eligibility, Nomination, and Selection of Officers", subsections A, C, and E: removed references to Fall Fellowship and explained that the process of electing Lodge Officers shall take place at "the first Lodge event held in the fall"
- 7. Pg 9 Article IV, Section 5, Subsection B "Lodge Vice Chiefs", subsection d, removed the word cub so that the Vice Chief of the East position will be responsible for "Camp Promotion"
- 8. Pg 10 Article IV, Section 6 "The Lodge Executive Committee": altered "Chairman of Operations Committee" to "Chairmen of Operating and Special Lodge Committees"
- Pg 10 Article IV, Section 7, Subsection C altered to say that "The Lodge Key 3 shall consist of the Lodge Chief, Lodge Advisor, the Council Scout Executive or his staff designee, and the Lodge Associate Advisor.
- 10. Pg 13, Article VI, Section 3, subsection B, altered to say that the LEC will present the Lodge annual budget no later than the January LEC, and that Chapters may have expenses approved in advance by submitting an annual Chapter budget to the LEC.
- 11. Pg 19, Appendix A, Lodge Vice Chief of Inductions, added Fall Ordeal to listed duties.
- 12. Pg 20, Appendix A, Lodge Vice Chief of Communications, added OA Troop Rep as a duty of the Communications Committee and added Budget, Merchandise, Trading Post, Patch Committee, and Fundraising as duties of the Finance Committee
- 13. Pg 21, Appendix A, Secretary, added Minutes, Parliamentarian, and Historian as duties of the Secretary
- 14. Pg 22-26, Appendix B, Chapter Structure, altered to match National Policy stating that Chapter Officers shall consist of a Chapter Chief, Chapter Vice Chief, and Chapter Secretary.


CATCH SOME HIGH ADVENTURE IN 2009!





Fall Fellowship - Chapter Challenge & Scoutreach

Scoutreach Units will camp with Chapters. Each chapter needs to appoint a Scoutreach Mentor to act as host to the Scoutreach unit assigned to it. The Host Chapter (WAP) will need names at the September LEC.

Clan & Individual Awards will be feathers. Each chapter will need to bring or find a stave to attach their awards to. The overall award will be a shield. The winning clan will be allowed to place a totem or symbol (no larger than 4") on the shield to signify their achievement.

(4 Arrowmen on a relay team: member stationed at particular places, first runner starts, gathers second runner, both run to gather third runner, all three run and gather fourth runner - start groups at staggered times.)

Cooking-Indian theme Clan or Individuals

Clans to be made up of 4-6 Arrowmen from the same Chapter. Scoutreach groups in patrols of 4-6 Scouts.

Chapters may have multiple clans and individuals competing. Places 1-5 will be recognized in each category. Only one clan's and one individual's scores for each event will be used for the Chapter Challenge Award.
