

#### LODGE CEREMONIALISTS EARN HONORS AT NOAC

The Order of the Arrow (OA) is the national honor society of the Boy Scouts of America (BSA). All ceremonies are performed by the youth members who put in many hours to memorize, practice, and conduct the ceremonies. Honor recognition at NOAC is an achievement!




