Order of the Arrow High Adventure 2011

OA High Adventure will be back next year and better than ever. In addition to the normal programs of Philmont Trail Crew, OA Canadian Odyssey, and Wilderness Voyage, National is introducing two new programs for the summer of 2011. These new programs are Summit Corps 2011 "The New River Experience" and Indian Summer 2011. In addition OA Ocean Adventure will be returning in 2011 after its one year hiatus.

INDIAN SUMMER

From dancing, to singing, to ceremonies and inductions, join your fellow Arrowmen in a week of American Indian activities and recreation. From August 1-6, 2011, over 1,000 Arrowmen will gather at the beautiful Ridgecrest Conference Center in Ridgecrest, North Carolina. Arrowmen from all parts of the country and abroad will be represented.

Summit Corps

The New River Experience will provide Arrowmen an opportunity of service at the New River Gorge National River in West Virginia. Cheerful service projects will include upgrading the trail bed of the Garden Grand Hike and Bike Trail to invasive species removal. The Garden Grand Hike and Bike Trail connects the New River Gorge National River and will run adjacent to the Boy Scout's new high adventure base and home of the Jamboree - The Summit: The Bechtel Family National Reserve. Lodge contingents have a choice of four sessions to attend - 1) July 3-9, 2) July 10-16, 3) July 17-23, and 4) July 24-30. Similar to *ArrowCorps5* and our High Adventure programs, the week will consist of service and recreation opportunities.

Vigil Honor Nominations Due at March LEC

Jaccos Towne Lodge makes its Vigil Honor selections in March. Nominations are due at the March 20^{th} LEC. The forms are available online. Start thinking about who is worthy now!

Any Arrowman may nominate another worthy Arrowman for the Vigil Honor. To be eligible, the Arrowman must be a registered member of the BSA, a due-paid member of OA, have been a Brotherhood member for at least two years, and have provided exceptional service. The Vigil Honor is a high mark of distinction and recognition reserved for those Arrowmen who, by reason of exceptional service, personal effort, and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions <u>beyond</u> the immediate responsibilities of their position of office to one or more of the following: Lodge, Order of the Arrow, Scouting community, or at Scout Camp.

The Vigil Honor is the highest honor that the Order of the Arrow can bestow upon its members for service to lodge, council, and Scouting!

'Tis the Season for Unit Elections, Camp Promotions, and Crossovers!

The season of OA Unit Elections, Camp Promotions and Webelos Crossovers is upon us!

It is an Arrowman's responsibility to serve Scouting and the Order by helping with Unit Elections and Camp Promotions at the unit level - often done together! Make sure you report Unit Election results to your Chapter and to the Lodge, and all Camp Promotions presentations should be reported to your District Camping Chair!

February also brings the height of Crossover season for Webelos crossing over into Boy Scout Troops! Various chapters have ceremonies to mark these Crossovers, and their participation in those ceremonies is often a high point for new Scouts and an effective recruiting tool for future Arrowmen to join ceremonial teams and help with Crossovers.
