Congratulations to all new Brotherhood members of the Lodge! If you are not yet a Brotherhood member and have been an active Scout and a member of the OA for at least 10 months, consider sealing your membership by obtaining the Brotherhood. The requirements for Brotherhood are: be a dues-paid Arrowman for at least 10 months; have a basic knowledge of the Ordeal (pass the Brotherhood review); write a letter to the Lodge saying how your service to Scouting has benefited from the OA and how you will continue to serve Scouting and the OA; and finally go through the Brotherhood Ceremony.

Arrowmen who are eligible are strongly encouraged to go through the necessary steps to seal their membership as a Brotherhood member of the Order of the Arrow. Becoming a Brotherhood also helps the Lodge achieve quality status!

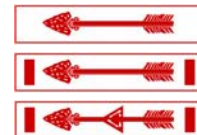

The New River Experience will provide Arrowmen an opportunity of service at the New River Gorge National River in West Virginia. Cheerful service projects will include upgrading the trail bed of the Garden Grand Hike and Bike Trail to invasive species removal. The Garden Grand Hike and Bike Trail connects the New River Gorge National River and will run adjacent to the Boy Scout's new high adventure base and home of the Jamboree - The Summit: The Bechtel Family National Reserve. Lodge contingents have a choice of four sessions to attend - 1) July 3-9, 2) July 10-16, 3) July 17-23, and 4) July 24-30. Similar to *ArrowCorps5* and OA High Adventure programs, the week will consist of service and recreation opportunities.
