Unit Elections Revisions and New Forms

Unit Election time is here, and there have been revisions to the adult nomination process and to forms for both youth and adults. See the Lodge's website at: http://districts.crossroadsbsa.org/oa/ for more information and the revised forms (including fillable PDFs).

The revised process for adult nominations is as follows: Each year, upon holding a troop or team election for youth candidates that results in at least one youth candidate being elected, the unit committee may nominate registered unit adults (age 21 or over) to the lodge adult selection committee. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the unit committee may nominate the currently-serving unit leader (but not assistant leaders), as long as he or she has served as unit leader for at least the previous 12 months. Recommendations of the adult selection committee, with the approval of the Scout executive, serving as Supreme Chief of the Fire, will be candidates for induction, provided all conditions are fulfilled.


2013 Patch Set

2012 Winter Banquet Report

The 2012 Winter Banquet was held on Saturday November 17th. The special guest speaker was Tony Steinhardt, Vice Chair Development, National Order of the Arrow Committee and member of Jaccos Towne Lodge. Tony was introduced by Council Executive Scott Clabaugh. Tony spoke about leadership, service, and some of the things that are or will happen in the Order of the Arrow. He encouraged youth Arrowmen to get involved with OA service through the Jamboree or High Adventure. Tony reported that there will be a revision of the Brotherhood ceremony coming out in 2013.



Tony also brought with him a copy of the commemorative painting commissioned for the 100th anniversary of the Order of the Arrow in 2015. It was created by Joseph Csatari, the official artist of the Boy

Scouts of America, and unveiled at the 2012 NOAC Conference. The painting, *Visions of the Founder*, is an art piece featuring a young E. Urner Goodman explaining to two Scouts what he envisions for the Order of the Arrow. This vision is of the things of the spirit - brotherhood, cheerfulness, and service - and is depicted in the painting's background.

2012 Lodge Chief Dan Spall presided over the program and was recognized for his service to the Lodge. Lodge Advisor Steve James was also recognized as the Banquet

as he has passed that position onto Rusty Helms for the next two years.
