2013 Vigil Nominations due

The Vigil Honor is reserved for those Arrowmen who, by reason of exceptional service, personal effort, and unselfish have made distinguished interest. the immediate contributions beyond responsibilities of their position or office to one or more of the following: their lodge, the Order of the Arrow, Scouting, or their Scout Camp. The candidate must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America AND a due-paid member of the Lodge. To nominate someone for the Vigil Honor, the nominator must fill out and submit a completed National Vigil Petition AND a Vigil Guide Form.

All Nomination and guide forms are due at the March LEC to either the Vigil Chair or Erik Wickizer. The Vigil Selection Meeting will start at 2:30 p.m. Sunday, April 14th. All Chapters are asked to send two members who are not eligible for Vigil, preferably one who is already Vigil. The committee would like the names of these Arrowmen by the March LEC.

Unit Elections Revisions and New Forms

Unit Election time is here, and there have been revisions to the adult nomination process and to forms for both youth and adults. See the Lodge's website at: http://districts.crossroadsbsa.org/oa/ for more information and the revised forms (including fillable PDFs).

The revised process for adult nominations is as follows: Each year, upon holding a troop or team election for youth candidates that result in at least one youth candidate being elected, the unit committee may nominate registered unit adults (age 21 or over) to the lodge adult selection committee. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the unit committee may nominate the currently-serving unit leader (but not assistant leaders), as long as he or she has served as unit leader for at least the previous 12 months. Recommendations of the adult selection committee. with the approval of the Scout executive, serving as Supreme Chief of the Fire, will be candidates for induction, provided all conditions are fulfilled.
