


Participate in OA at Summer Camp

Section C-6A consists of six Order of the Arrow lodges from Indiana and Illinois. The lodges are <u>Jaccos Towne</u> (Crossroads of America Council), <u>Kiondaga</u> (Buffalo Trace Council), <u>Sakima</u> (LaSalle Council), <u>Takachsin</u> (Sagamore Council), Nischa Chuppecat (Hoosier Trails Council), and <u>Kiskakon</u> (Anthony Wayne Council).

Purpose of the Section

An Order of the Arrow section consists of lodges within a geographic area of the region. Once every year, representatives of lodges in the section come together for a conclave to share in fellowship, skills, and training. In addition, the section creates a monitoring/mentoring relationship with its lodges, provides leadership development opportunities, fosters understanding and adherence to national OA policies and procedures, and coordinates OA administrative and program functions. A section is led by three elected youth officers, the section chief, section vice chief, and section secretary, who are advised by adult section advisers and a professional section staff adviser.
