Special Details about Lodge Ordeal from Ordeal Master Max Kitchell

- I) Due to COVID-19 restrictions from the council and Monroe County, we have capped registration at 100 candidates and 50 Arrowmen (Vigil and Brotherhood candidates count under Arrowmen, not candidates). Also, it means we will run parallel ceremonies for Ordeal and Pre-Ordeal. This results in a need for even more help from all of you since we need to set up twice as many fires and rings.

We want to keep everyone safe during this pandemic, and safety is more important than the Ordeal, so we need you to abide by these regulations.
