Winter Events



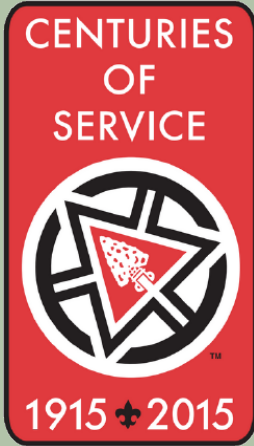
