


Firecrafter/OA Service Day Wrap Up

Vigil Nominations

Accepting Vigil Honor Petitions now to April 30th!!

The Vigil Honor is the highest honor in the Order of the Arrow and is awarded to Arrowmen who live by the Scout Oath and Law, and who demonstrate cheerful service in daily life. In order for a member to be considered for this great achievement, they must have been a Brotherhood member for at least two years, be a registered member of the Order of the Arrow, and be in good standing with the lodge.




