OA Ordeal Weekends Start This Month

Each year, approximately 300 Scouts and Scouters from the Crossroads of America Council complete the Ordeal and become members of Order of the Arrow.

As an Arrowman in Wulakamike Lodge #21, you can help make entrance into OA more meaningful for these candidates by participating in one or more of the chapter-sponsored Ordeals.

Seven Ordeal weekends will be held this spring. A schedule and registration form are included on page 2 of this Goodlander. Please plan to attend at least one of the Ordeals. You may register for an Ordeal by contacting the appropriate chapter representative or else by sending your form and money to the Council office.

In most instances, chapters are charging the following fees for the Ordeals:

- Ordeal candidate -- \$20
- Brotherhood candidate -- \$20
- Brotherhood/Elangomat -- \$16
- Elangomat -- \$6
- Member -- \$13

There are some exceptions, however. Wapsuchuppecatt Chapter is charging \$21 for Ordeal and Brotherhood candidates. Lowaneu Allanque Chapter is charging \$23 for Ordeal candidates. And Lobarlewhense Chapter is charging \$21 for Brotherhood candidates, \$20 for Brotherhood/Elangomats,

\$10 for Elangomats and \$16 for members.

If you have been a member of the Order of the Arrow for at least 10 months, you are encouraged to seal your membership in OA by completing the Brotherhood requirements during one of the Ordeals. Brotherhood members may be distinguished from Ordeal members by the red bars at the top and bottom of their sashes. Brotherhood members in Wulakamike Lodge also receive a second restricted pocket flap.

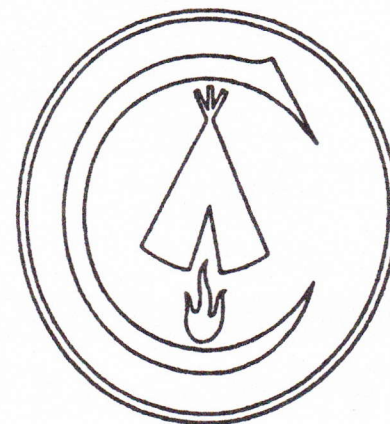

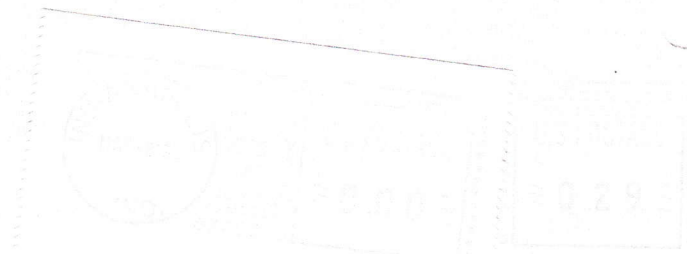
